Research

Watch the birds in your garden or local park. Look at them closely with binoculars.

Literacy

Work with an adult to produce photo strip story photographs using toys, puppets or models. Evergreen bushes and a rocky or dusty area of your garden or local park would make perfect sets!

Science

Find non-fiction books at home (or in the local library) about dinosaur write a fact file.


