Dear Parent/Guardian,

Further to my letter requesting nominations for our parent governor vacancy on the school's governing body, I am writing to let you know that the elections for these vacancies will be held over the five day period 16<sup>th</sup> to 20<sup>th</sup> January 2017 inclusive.

Every individual parent of a child at the school is entitled to one vote per vacancy. You may, therefore, vote for 1 candidate on the enclosed ballot paper. The ballot is secret.

In addition to the ballot paper you will find a list of parents standing for election as parent governors and any statements that they have chosen to submit for you to read. There is also an unmarked envelope for the return of your ballot paper.

To vote all you need to do is:

- 1 Mark a cross (X) next to the name of the person you wish to vote for. Please do NOT write your name or any other mark on the ballot paper.
2. When you have voted, place the ballot paper in the smaller white envelope and seal it. Please do NOT write on the envelope.
- 3 Write your name and the name of any of your children at the school on a separate piece of paper;
- 4 Send this paper and the small sealed white envelope together in the larger white envelope to the Head Teacher either:
  - (a) by first class post (to reach the school by 1pm on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2017).
  - (b) by a pupil at the school, to arrive no later than 1.00 pm on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2017.

On arrival the separate piece of paper with your name on it will be checked to make sure you have not voted twice. It will then be thrown away. The small sealed envelope will be placed, still sealed, in a ballot box to await the end of the election.

On Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January the ballot box will be opened, the envelopes unsealed and the votes counted. The successful candidate will be the one with the greatest number of votes. In the event of a tie, a coin will be tossed to decide the winner.

I will let you know the results in due course.

Your ballot paper must be returned to the school by 1pm Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> January.


